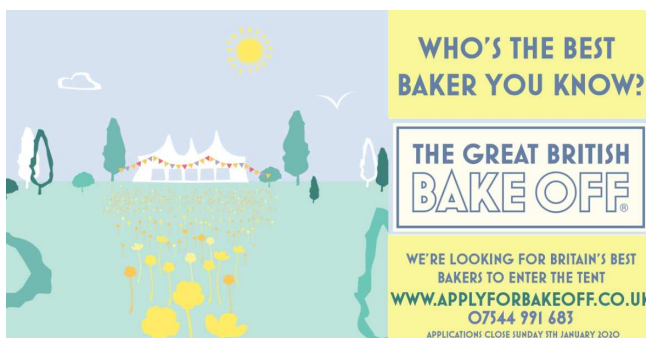
Information
